ENGAGE IN EVERYDAY MOMENTS TOGETHER



Morning Time

When you go into your child's room, cuddle them and say: "Good morning! God tells us in the Bible that He loves us so much!"



Cuddle Time

Cuddle with your child and pray: "God, thank You that Your Word, the Bible, is true."



Drive Time

While on the go, ask your child what is their favorite story. Then say: "The Bible is filled with a lot of stories that are true and tell us about how awesome God is."



Bath Time

As you give your child a bath, ask them: "Who are the people who help you?" Explain how Tabatha and Timothy lived for God and helped people.
